****Important Changes****

Similar to last year, the Light Horses Judging CDE will not be held at CSU Chico. However, a horse judging contest will be offered by Red Bluff FFA and the results will be shared at the Field Day.

The Floriculture CDE will not have a preliminary contest on Friday to reduce the need for hotels.
